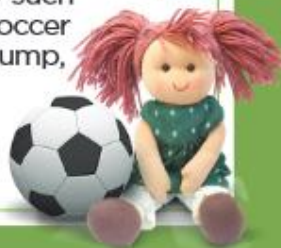


Get a standard size shoebox to pack for a boy or girl. Need shoeboxes? Pre-printed shoeboxes are available online.
