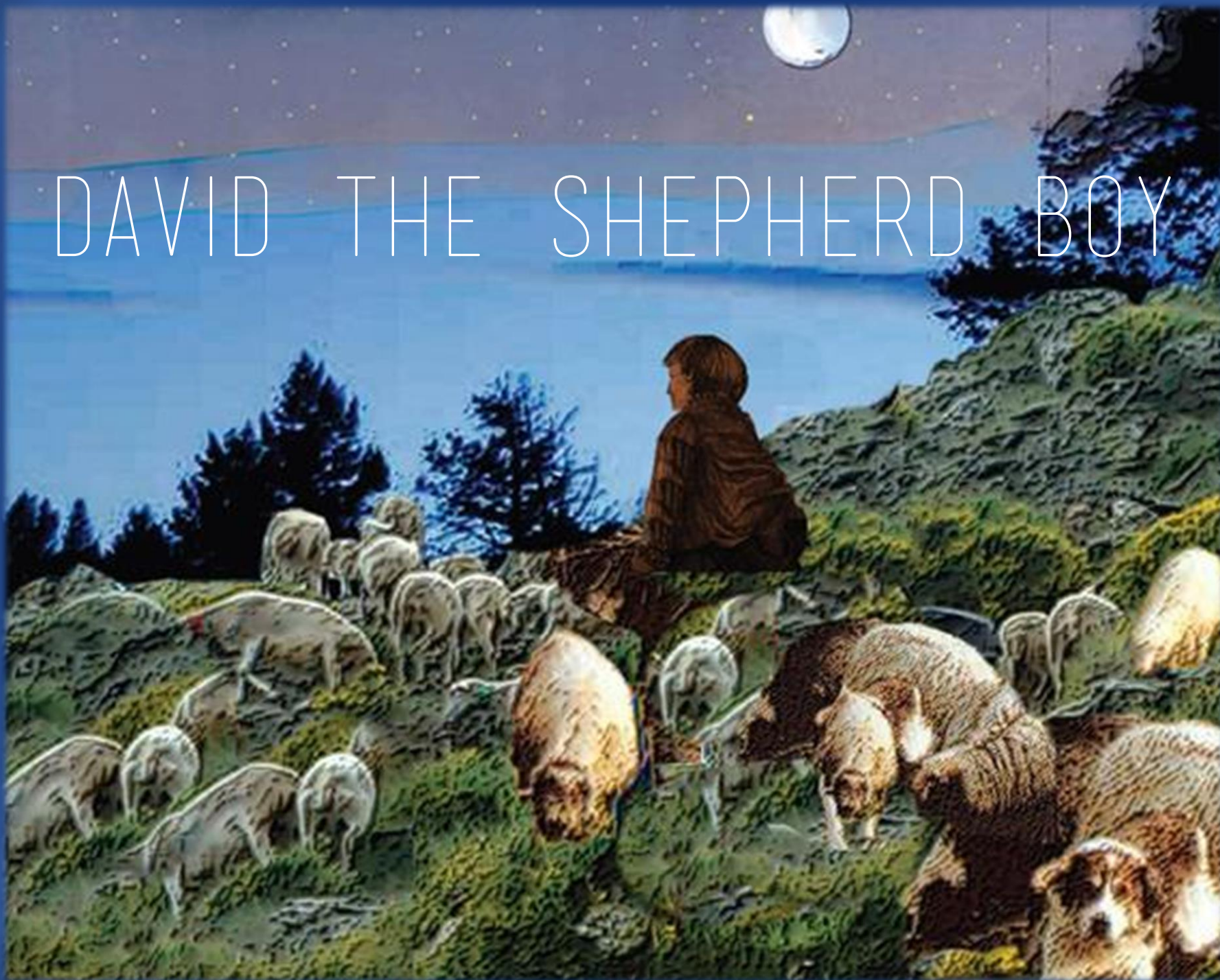
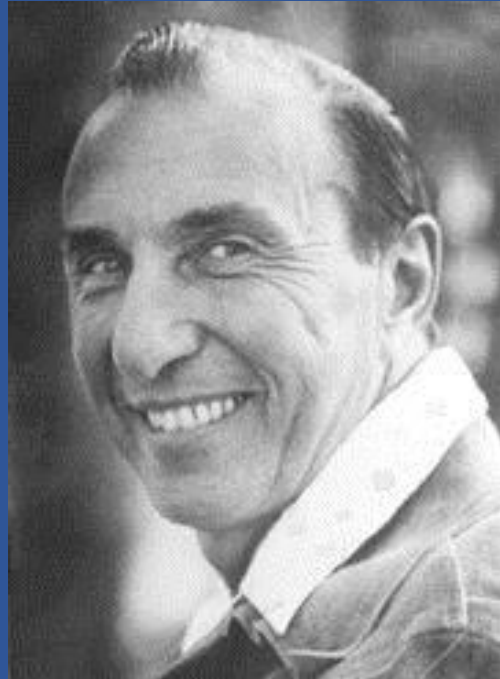

An Important Question

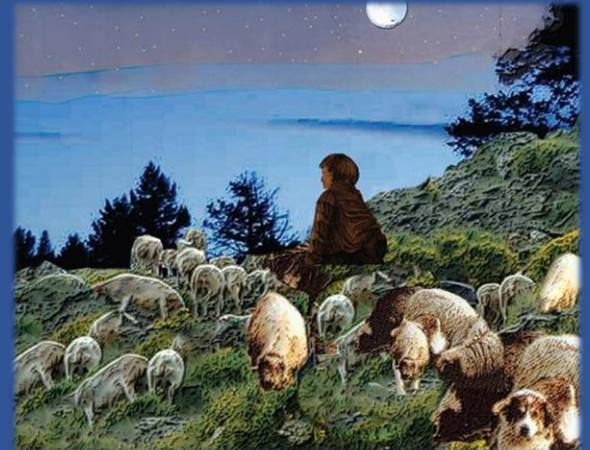
1) Is the Lord Your Shepherd

2) Are you a sheep belonging to the Master Shepherd



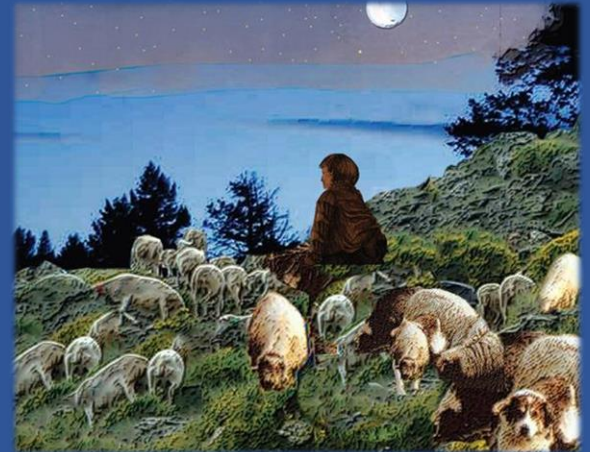
3) His Position

- one of the Lord's Sheep

- the apple of His eye



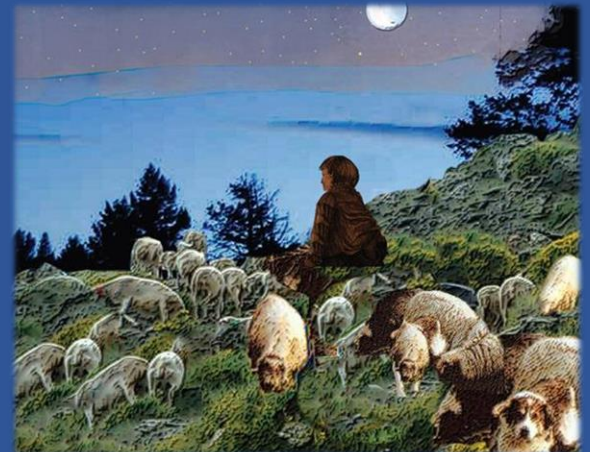
Can you hear David declare his pride and devotion? Look at who my shepherd, manager, owner is.
