Summary

This sermon explores the story of Joseph, the earthly father of Jesus, as found in Matthew 1:18-25. 8. What steps can we take to strengthen our faith when facing uncertainty?

Life Application

This week, identify an area in your life where your plans have not gone as expected. Spend time in prayer, asking God to reveal His purpose in this situation and to help you trust in His greater plan.
