2025-03-09 - The Secret Life You Can't Hide From God

Summary

The sermon focuses on the Free Methodist Church's stance against secret societies and expands into a broader discussion about secrecy in Christian life. Pastor Thomas explains that while the historical context was about Masonic lodges infiltrating church leadership, the principle applies to how we handle secrets in our lives today. The main message emphasizes that God is omniscient (all-knowing) and that while we often try to hide our sins and broadcast our achievements, Scripture teaches us to do the opposite - confess our sins openly while keeping our good works private.

- 7. What are some practical ways we can practice humility with our achievements?
- 8. How can we create a safe environment where people feel comfortable being honest about their struggles?

This week, practice intentional transparency with God and a trusted Christian friend. Choose one struggle or challenge you've been keeping to yourself and share it with them, asking for prayer and support. Additionally, when you do something praise-worthy, practice keeping it between you and God.
